Her service has been sustained, substantive, and focused on governance. She has served as President of the Young Lawyers Division, as an elected member of the Board of Governors since 2018, and as a member of the Executive Committee. She has chaired or co-chaired key committees including Disciplinary Review, Communications, Technology, and Program Evaluation. These roles require diligence, institutional knowledge, and careful oversight.
